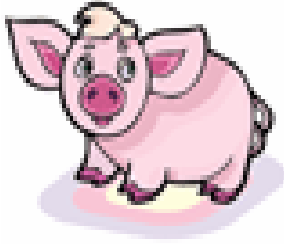
Decorating Contest- Sat. 12-18

Pork Butts, Here We Go Again!



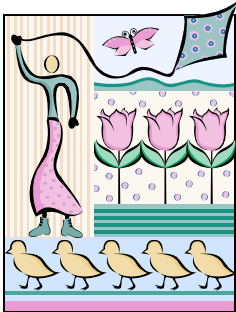
Our Lynco cooks are doing it again! They will be cooking up some delicious pork butts for your holiday dinner.

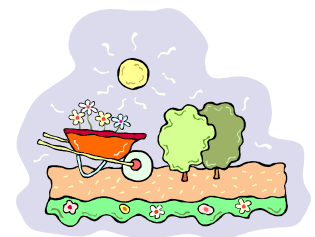

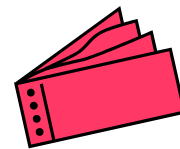
White Elephant Sale Was Great!
